That question arose in the last chapter (#21) of the 2011 book, when Dr. A. was preparing to retire and unexpected circumstances allowed him to continue and complete the above first (Clinical) researches into the question in six Phases. Then the work moved to the second, remarkably-systematic, increasingly-deeper, (Self Analytic) researches. And all of them led to never-encountered infant-child symptom depths that, though very frightening (e.g. one touched the roots of a psychotic symptom), threw light upon that puzzle.

The work also produced an expansive collection of material that clearly points towards a potential answer to the Psychoanalytic Profession’s persistent, aggressive, nasty and dismissive responses to my researches and papers that are always rejected for journal publications. It has no scientifically-created theory of “Surfaces and Layers) and never moves in the direction of developing one. And any movement towards an increasing ability to “go deeper” to absolute symptom-root depths in in selves and patients, will be unwittingly annexed by an unknowable (because “repressed”) danger of major proportions

The on-the-spot, extensively-detailed, M.F Self-Analytic parts of the above researches, will be amazingly interesting to professionals who are not hidebound traditionalists. May they read this book, and expand the research beyond what Dr. A was happily able to accomplish in his lifetime.
